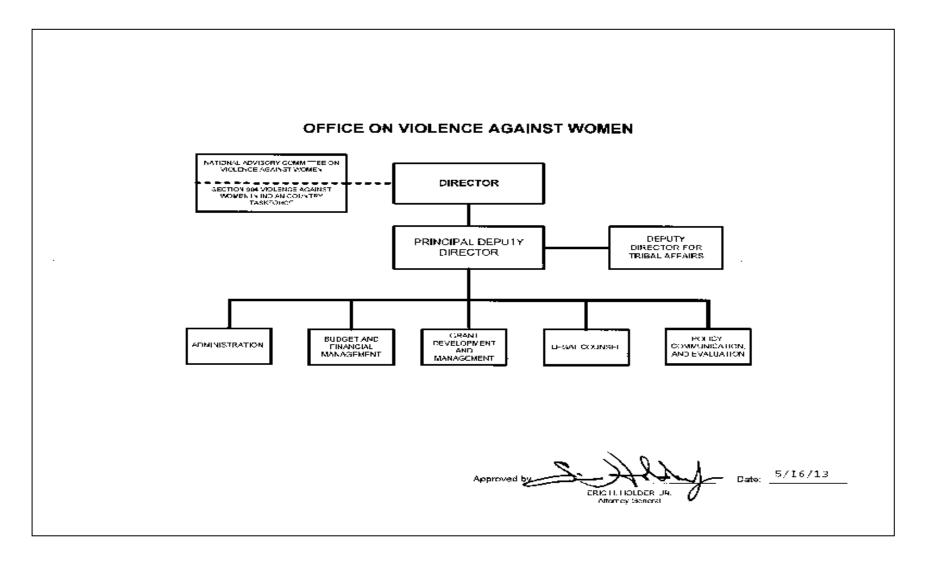
# **A: Organizational Chart - OVW Grant Programs**

Sexual Assault Survivors' Rights Implementation Senate Report p. 68

The Survivors' Bill of Rights Act of 2016 (Public Law 114–236) directed the Department, in conjunction with the Department of Health and Human Services, to establish a joint working group to develop, coordinate, and disseminate best practices regarding the care and treatment of sexual assault survivors and the preservation of forensic evidence. The Committee looks forward to the report requested in Senate Report 115–139 and codified in Public Law 115–141 as well as the timely completion of the working group's report to Congress containing its findings and recommended actions.
